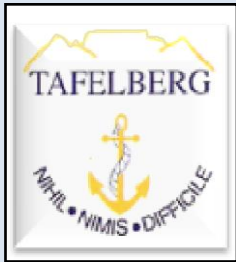

2. School fees 2019

Tafelberg is a Section 21 fee-paying school, and the SA Schools Act thus places a duty on the SGB to collect such school fees from all parents as agreed upon at the parent AGM. The Budget and school fees for 2019 were voted on at the parent AGM on 7 November 2018. The Budget, school fee increase and certain policies (e.g. Code of Conduct, Uniform and Appearance, Language, Religious, and Admission policies among others) were tabled and accepted by a majority vote of parents at the AGM.

- 10% discount on fees if paid in full before end of February 2019
- First Debit Order run : 1st working day of each month
- Fees are paid over 11 months, starting January 2019 (for 2019 fees)
- Exemptions and non-payment of fees are dealt with as per legislation and school policy.

3. Safety and security

Continuing with the theme of safety and security, please note the following :

- Any meeting with a member of staff must be pre-arranged (SA Schools Act) and no parent/visitor/official may visit any classroom without the permission of the Principal or Deputies.
- All visitors must report to the school secretary, and be issued with a visitor card.
- Any visitor/parent/learner or member of staff may be searched should there be reasonable suspicion of drugs, dangerous weapons, alcohol etc. This includes vehicles entering the school property.
- No smoking is allowed on school grounds nor in the buildings.
- All visitors/parents are subject to the safety and security regulations of the school.
- No visitor, parent or learner may climb on roofs or walls, nor over fences and gates.
- Visitors, parents, learners and staff entering the school grounds in a motor vehicle must adhere to the signs and speed limit indicated.
- No visitor/parent may take photographs of any Tafelberg learner on the school property.
