

# Speech-Language Therapy Tips

So much that happens in the classroom relies on your child being able to listen to information and then recall it. Play these games with them to encourage them to listen and remember.

## **Musical Statues**

Play some music, when the music stops, so should your child.

## **Simon Says**

Use easy one-part instructions initially, until your child gets the concept of moving only when Simon says it. Then increase the length and complexity of the instruction.

## **"I Went to ..."**

Recite a long list of items and then add one, alphabetically, for the next player to remember.

Like this:

"I went to the zoo and I saw an anteater, a bear, a crocodile, a deer, an elephant and ... a ferret!"

## **Code Breaker**

Play a game where your child must repeat a secret code in order to do something he wants.

Like this:

"If you want to watch TV, you must repeat the secret code: 47832" or "cat, house, wash, bubble" or "I went to the shop and bought a red spinning top".
