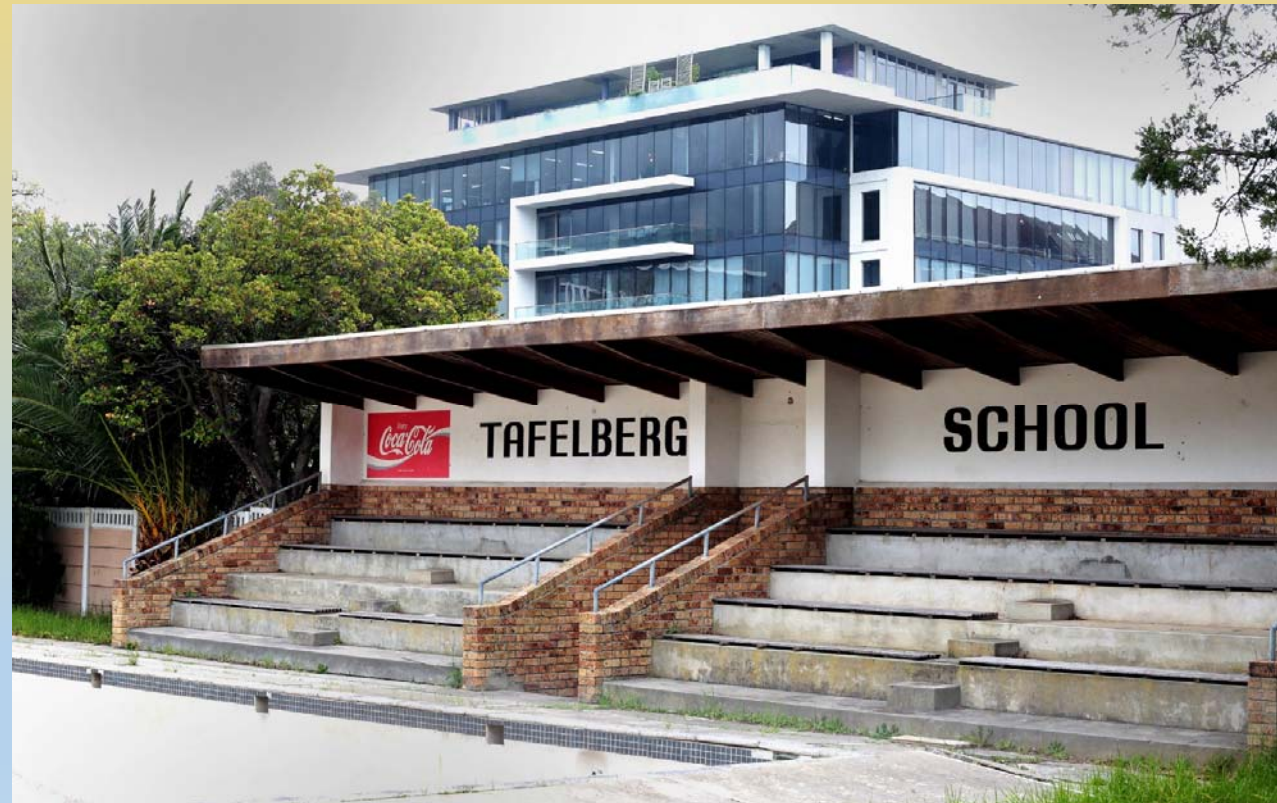

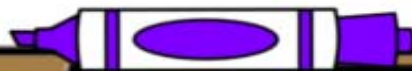

- With this, we appeal from you to help us instil discipline at all times to your children.

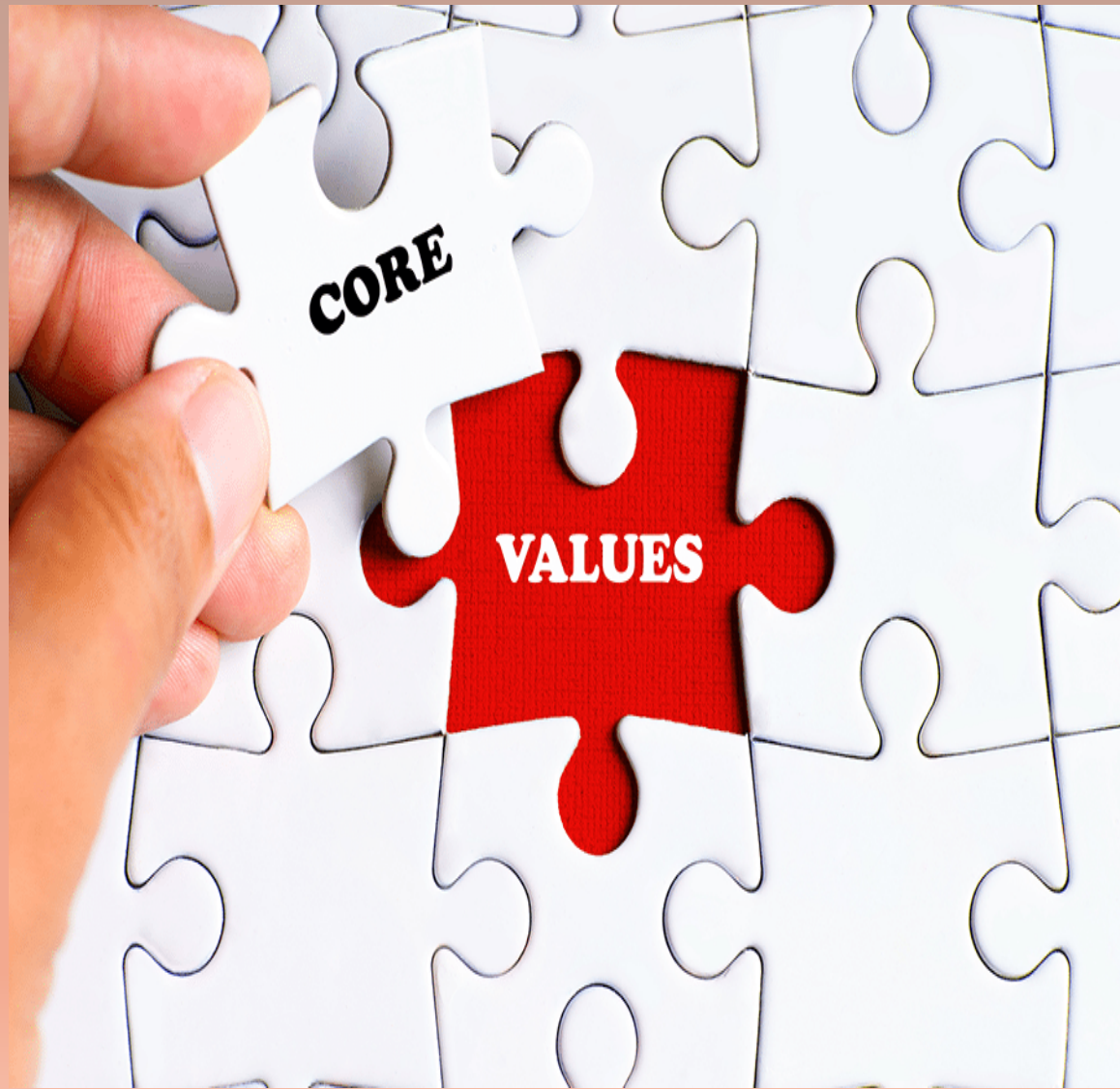
1. Be at school : absenteeism
